



250 HWASONG-11D FOR BORDER GUARDS

MILITARY INTELLIGENCE REPORT



SUMMARY

North Korea held a ceremony to hand over 250 Hwasong-11D operational-tactical missile launchers to the KPA, an unprecedented batch. These missiles have a range of just over 200 km, similar to the Soviet "Tochka-U." This quantity can equip over 20 brigades, each with 12 launchers. In comparison, the last Soviet army year had 15 brigades with 12-16 launchers each. Each launcher is equipped with four missiles, making a volley of 1,000 missiles possible.

Simpler, numerous, and cheaper missiles are crucial in North Korea's missile forces. While high-performance missiles like the KN-23 are produced at a slower rate, simpler missiles are cheaper and easier to mass-produce, accurate, and reliable. These can also have nuclear variants. These developments underscore North Korea's ongoing efforts to enhance its military strength and nuclear deterrence capabilities.



NEW TACTICAL BALLISTIC MISSILE LAUNCHERS

- Introduction: Kim Jong-un unveiled 250 new tactical ballistic missile launchers at a recent military event. These launchers are designed to deploy short-range ballistic missiles and are intended to bolster North Korea's rapid deployment capabilities.
- Event Details: The unveiling took place in Pyongyang and was marked by a large ceremony with military demonstrations and public displays. This expansion reflects North Korea's strategy to enhance its military readiness and regional deterrence.
