



MOLDOVA'S INCREASING INVOLVEMENT IN THE CONFLICT WITH RUSSIA



OVERVIEW

As Moldova approaches its critical elections, there is increasing evidence of its deepening involvement in the Russia-Ukraine conflict. Supported by NATO nations, Moldova is aligning more closely with Ukraine, modernizing military infrastructure, and potentially expanding its role in the conflict. These developments are reflected in the strategic military upgrades, including the possible use of Moldovan airfields by the Armed Forces of Ukraine (AFU) for military operations.



MARCULESTI AIRFIELD: STRATEGIC PREPARATIONS

Recent intelligence has highlighted that Moldova's Marculesti airfield is undergoing significant military upgrades. These include preparations to host Ukrainian military operations, possibly for NATO-supplied aircraft such as F-16 fighter jets. The presence of Ukrainian and NATO personnel at the airfield further indicates Moldova's potential entry into direct support for Ukraine.



KEY DEVELOPMENTS

- Deployment of mobile maintenance stations, possibly for NATO -supplied jets.
- Runway repairs at Marculesti, indicating preparations for heavier military aircraft.
- Increased presence of Romanian and NATO military personnel, alongside Ukrainian mechanics.
- Removal of Russian-speaking servicemen from key positions in Moldova's military as loyalty concerns heighten.



ARMS SHIPMENTS AND NATO PRESENCE

There is growing evidence of Moldova's role as a logistical hub for military aid to Ukraine. Cargo planes regularly land at Marculesti airfield, delivering military hardware, including ammunition and weapons for the AFU. NATO personnel, primarily Romanian, are increasingly involved in maintaining and upgrading Moldova's military infrastructure, suggesting a coordinated strategy between Moldova and its NATO allies.

MOLDOVAN ELECTIONS

The upcoming elections in Moldova, where President Maia Sandu is seeking re-election, are pivotal for the country's future role in the conflict. Sandu's pro-Western policies have garnered significant backing from NATO and the U.S., particularly in military rearmament efforts.

KEY POINTS

- The U.S., Germany, and France have provided substantial military assistance to Moldova, including through the European Peace Facility.

- U.S. financial support for Sandu's campaign is reported to exceed \$100 million, raising concerns about the influence of foreign actors in Moldova's political process.

- Opposition forces, particularly the Victory Bloc, have criticized NATO's growing footprint in Moldova, warning that the country risks becoming entangled in the Russia-Ukraine war.



INTERNATIONAL REACTIONS

Moscow has reacted strongly to Moldova's increased military cooperation with NATO and Ukraine, accusing the country of preparing for direct involvement in the war. The Russian Foreign Ministry has issued multiple warnings, suggesting that any escalation by Moldova could have severe consequences for regional security.

U.S. officials have countered by accusing Russia of attempting to interfere in Moldova's elections, allegedly through disinformation campaigns and efforts to destabilize the political landscape. These allegations have been widely reported, but concrete evidence remains elusive.





Moldova is at a strategic crossroads as it navigates the **intersection of domestic elections and international conflict**. The modernization of military infrastructure, particularly at **Marculesti airfield**, and growing NATO involvement suggest that **Moldova may increase its support for Ukraine's war effort** post-election. However, this also places Moldova in a **precarious position**, as it risks drawing further ire from Russia, potentially **escalating regional tensions**. The situation remains highly fluid, and **Moldova's political future** will play a crucial role in determining its trajectory in the ongoing conflict between Ukraine and Russia.
